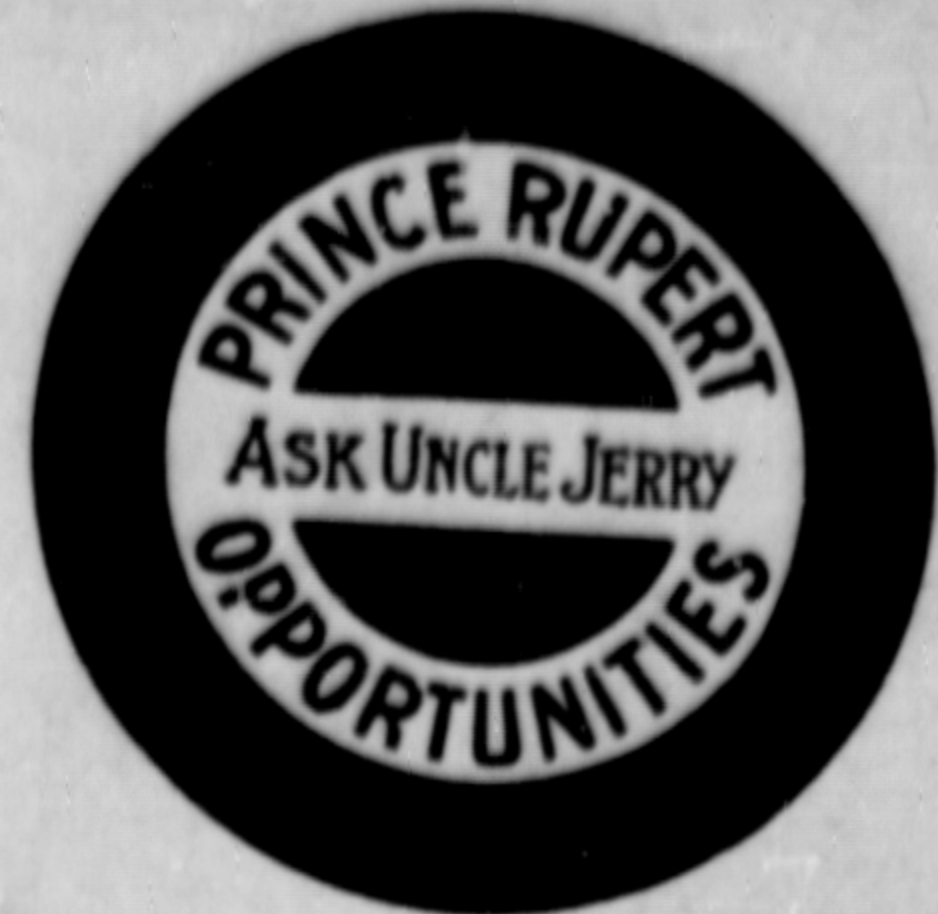

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MIGHTY LUMBER INDUSTRY LOCATING ITS DISTRIBUTION CENTRE IN PRINCE RUPERT

People in Prince Rupert have hardly yet properly realized the immense proportions of the Ocean Falls Lumber plant and saw mills, the distributing headquarters of which are soon to be established in Rupert.

The mill will plant in a battery of six immense sawdust burning boilers. The pulp mill is run by electricity generated by water power.

The company has had a force of over a thousand men in its logging camps, besides many hand loggers working on their own account since early in the year, and are getting a large reserve stock of logs ahead in their booms.

"Live" Mill Throughout Mr. Borroughs, the company's manager for Prince Rupert and the north, is in receipt of information to the effect that one side of the company's immense double mill at Ocean Falls is now in operation, and the other side being rapidly replaced in readiness for operation.
