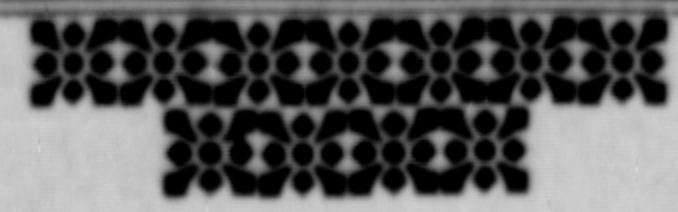

What is needed is the co-operation of tens of thousands of great-hearted, broad-minded, democratic women, who will welcome the strangers as guests, steer them away from the dangers that beset the lonely and friendless, and help to cure the dread disease of homesickness.

serves. At the same time, there are many complaints of the scarcity of domestic helpers. Let those who feel the need take the lead in raising domestic service to its rightful honored place. Then it will be easier to dispel the prejudices that exist in the minds of workers.

Few of us realize the situation of a girl who comes to Canada from other lands, or to the city from the country—the cutting off of familiar associations, the appalling loneliness and homesickness, the narrow life in the boarding house, the craving for company that makes the stranger seek the bright and crowded streets.—Toronto Star.
