ONE THOUSAND FARMERS TO SETTLE DISTRICT

(Continued from Page 1.)

same plan. This method gives the settlers every facility for the rapid development of the farms.

Houses and buildings are to be erected at a central point in each community and the nucleus of a town started. The garden truck and vegetables will be grown close to the village, where the women and children can aid in looking after it, while the grain and hay will be cultivated in the distant fields.

Within thirty days the first of the settlers will arrive. These will be about thirty in number, who will immediately start building houses and buildings for the accommodation of the balance of the colonists upon their arrival.

All the families are well-to-do farmers from Russia, and are all provided with sufficient funds to maintain them until the land returns them the product of their labors. The calibre of the new settlers can be judged from their first request to the government, which is for a school. The only other favor they desire is for the establishment of a post office.

The system is a non-political, non-religious co-operative scheme where all work for the commonwealth, aiming to attain

MINERS MUST BE IN NEED BEFORE SHOOTING A DEER

NEW PROVISION IN GAME ACT WILL TAKE FROM MINER THE RIGHT TO KILL DEER FOR FOOD UNLESS HE IS STARVING.

Victoria, Oct. 4.—Some changes which have been made in the operation of the Provincial game laws this year seem to have aroused a good deal of misplaced indignation. It is true that prospectors in unorganized districts may kill game out of season if it is necessary for them to do so in order to sustain life.

What has happened, however, is that a number of districts are now organized which were formerly unorganized, such as the Slocan, Similkameen, Esquimalt and elsewhere. These were places easy of access, and it was found that some persons were taking out a miner's license and then shooting in these districts

without paying further on the privilege. While these were unorganized districts they were able to do this legally, and a considerable number of persons, even from over the border, had discovered this method of securing hunting privileges at a cheap rate.

By declaring the districts organized this practice has been put to a stop. No hardship has been inflicted on the prospector, the officials declare, because there is no organized district in the province where a prospector is so far from help that he is compelled to live by his rifle. He can always reach a settlement and obtained food supplies if he has the price.
