same plan. This method gives the settlers every facility for the rapid development of the farms. Houses and buildings are to be erected at a central point in each community and the nucleus of a town started. The garden truck and vegetables will be grown close to the village, where the women and children can aid looking after it, while the grain and hay will be cultivated in the distant fields.

Within thirty days the first of the settlers will arrive. These will be about thirty in number, ROYAL - DAIRY ing houses and buildings for the accommodation of the balance of the colonists upon their arrival.

All the families are well-to-do farmers from Russia, and are all Phone 35 provided with sufficient funds to maintain them until the land returns them the product of their labors.
