THE STANDING
BRITISH ARMY

Prince Rupert Boy Receives Let-
ter from War Office Saying
575,276 Men in Army.

The following letter from the
war office received by Master J.
W. Dowling, son of Mr. F. Dowling
of the government telegraph
service, who is an enthusiastic
Boy Scout and loyal Canadian, is
the answer to an inquiry as to
the war footing of the British
army, and is extremely interest-
ing at this time when so much
talk is being heard as to the
probability of war with Germany.
"In reply to your letter, re-
ceived on the 3rd instant, in
which you ask for the number of
men serving in the British army
at home and abroad, I am com-
mended by the army council to
convey to you the following de-
tails of effectives, all ranks, on
1st January last, which, it is
hoped, will supply the informa-
tion you require:

Regular forces (regimental)
home and colonial, including the
regular establishment of special
reserve, 167,354.

Special reserve, excluding regu-
lar establishment, 61,951.

Territorial force, including
permanent staff, 268,414.

Regular forces (regimental) on
Indian establishment, 77,557.

These are white troops serving in
India and do not include the In-
dian native regiments.

The figures are exclusive of
all reserves.

MAYOR'S HOUSE
SEIZED BY LAW

Bailiff Sits in Parlor of Mayor
Beckwith's Home in Victoria
and Will Stay Until Paid.

Victoria, Nov. 4.—A bailiff is
in possession at 1423 Fernwood
road, the home of John L. Beck-
with, mayor of Victoria.

Some three weeks ago in the
Supreme Court in the case of
Barnum vs. Beckwith, a judgment
for \$1,000 and costs, making
\$1,700 in all, was secured against
the mayor. He had fifteen days
in which to enter an appeal or
pay the money. He did neither.
He was then notified by Mr. Bar-
num's solicitors that further ac-
tion would be taken unless he
paid up within one week. At the
expiration of the week the mayor
had done nothing, so the bailiff
was put in possession Saturday.

To Await Assizes.

In Judge Young's court this
morning the man, A. E. McKenzie,
sent up for trial on a charge of
attempted robbery from a drunken
man upon the premises of the
Empress Hotel, elected to take
his trial before a jury at the as-
sises on the 20th inst. He still
in the option of changing his
request to a speedy trial and it is
thought he may possibly do this
upon the obtaining of certain wit-
nesses that he requires for his
defense.
