ROYAL GEORGE STARTS ON GLASGOW RUN TODAY

Big Steamer Stranded in the St. Lawrence Is Ready for Her Trip.

Quebec, Dec. 6. - There is every indication that the C. N. R. steamer Royal George will be ready to sail for Glasgow on Saturday. The bottom of the vessel under No. 2 hold has been temporarily repaired and in the words of Captain Thompson, marine superintendent of the company, is now as tight as a corked bottle. Yesterday a survey of the vessel was proceeded with and a sworn statement was made by Diver Begin regarding the repairs and the steamer's ability to proceed safely to sea.

WOULD HAVE PRESIDENT CHOSEN BY DIRECT VOTE

Measure to Be Introduced to Have Personal Voting for the President.

Washington, Dec. 6 .- Senator Works, of California, introduced in the Senate a joint resolution proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the election by direct vote of the president and vice president of the United States.

The bill provides that each state's returns be certified by the Secretary of State of the United States before January 1, following the election, and that the Secretary of State shall certify the returns to the President of the Senate before February 1st. when the winner will be nounced.


