### Ex-Governor Congdon.

Mr. Congdon, who first went north in 1901 as public administrator, representing the Dominion government, was perhaps the cleverest and most accomplished man that ever went into the land of the midnight sun. Holding consecutively the appointments of public administrator, legal adviser to the governor and council, crown prosecutor and governor of the Yukon he assuredly played an important part in the history of the Klondyke during its early days. Later he represented the huge territory in the Dominion House, being defeated at the last general election by Dr. Alfred Thompson.
