restaurant, one of the city's finest eating places, will

be re-opening tomorrow after being closed for reno-

vations. The La Gondola closed February 6 for renovations to the cafe, dining room and kitchen. Originally general manager John Barazzuol and assistant manager. Peter Moroz had planned to expand the restaurant. But plans were changed to complete

renovations only. Some of the work completed included the laying of an entirely new floor, new plumbing. new lighting in the dining room. a new heating system, painting and some redecorating.

Gold-covered, wall covering enhances certain portions of the case while copper tones add to the walls of the dining room.

New deep fryers, a salad table and a new ventilation system have been added to the kitchen. The restaurant was first renoyated in June, 1954 when Johnny and Pete took over the Galley Cafe at 353 Third Avenue West and renamed it La Gondola. Then, as now, the restaurant was a favorite eating place for athletes, sports fans and connoisseurs of good food.

The restaurant was again renovated from June to July, 1957 when it closed for an entire month.

Then the work included a complete modernization program.

Two large picture windows. based on Roman brick, were part of the work. The new familiar black wrought iron ornament in the outline of a Venetian Gondola was added.

The "Venetian Room," the restaurant's dining room, was also added and the kitchen was enlarged and new equipment in-
