Proposition Made by Employers and Merchants to Trades Council

The following is the scale of wages proposed by the Employers and Merchants Association to the Trades and Labor Council of Nelson: Outside laborers, including cement mixers, \$3.25 for 9 hours. Inside laborers, \$3 for nine hours. All ordinary labor outside connected with building, \$3 for nine hours. Mortar mixers and quarrymen, \$3.50 for nine hours. Brickyard laborers, \$3.25 for nine hours. Machinists at Nelson Iron Works, \$4.35 for nine hours. Common labor at ironworks, \$3 for nine hours. Painters, \$4 for nine hours. Teamsters, \$80 per month with a nine hour day. Teamsters, helpers, \$3 for nine hours.
