

## PUBLIC RESENTMENT SEEN OVER USE OF CHEMICALS

OTTAWA (CP) — A conference of North American forestry experts told today that public resentment in the United States against the use of chemical insect controls is forcing the U.S. forest service into a crash program of research on biological control.

Edward Cliff, chief of the U.S. forest service, warned that "a strong body of public resentment" has formed as the result of Rachel Carson's best-seller, Silent Spring, which outlined the wildlife problems caused by the use of chemicals in farming and forestry.
