ISOLATION NO BAR TO GIVE EDUCATION

Province to Supply Teachers for Children of Lighthouse Keepers.

Victoria, May 21.—Upon the recommendation of influential parliamentary members the provincial government has decided to establish a system of education for lighthousekeepers' children, who by reason of their location away from the mainland are prevented from benefiting from the educational facilities provided in British Columbia.

The system to be adopted will be on the lines of the Trinity Light Service, in force on the coasts of Great Britain, and will go into effect without delay. Teachers will make periodical tours to the various light stations in elementary and advanced courses.

The matter was enthusiastically taken up and brought to the notice of the Hon. Dr. Young, minister of education, by Mr. G. H. Barnard, M. P.; Mr. H. Shepherd, M. P.; Mr. H. C. Clements, M. P.; Mr. R. F. Green, M. P., and Captain George Robertson, agent of marine and fisheries.

BRITISH SECRETARY ACTING AS PEACEMAKER

London Newspaper Says Alien Law Treats Japanese as Semi-Barbarians

London, May 24.—Regarding the controversy between the United States and Japan the Daily Mail in an editorial says: "It seems unlikely that Japan will force a rupture with so potent an adversary over a matter of this kind, but the Webb law treats the Japanese as if they were only semi-barbarians and Asiatic undesirables. The aspersion rouses them to fury, and in their anger they may drive their government to perilous lengths. The gravity of the situation has a close personal interest for ourselves. It would be distressing to find our American kinsmen in a serious conflict with our Japanese allies upon an issue in which the Americans would command the sympathies of Western Canada and Australia."

"It may be taken for granted that Sir Edward Grey, whose peacemaking has been less amateurish than Secretary Bryan's, will use all legitimate means to bring the disputants to an understanding."
