NO CUSTOMS DUTY CHARGED ON GOODS GOING INTO SHUSHANA

CANADIAN CUSTOMS DEPARTMENT WAIVES RESTRICTIONS ON AMERICAN GOODS PASSING THROUGH YUKON TERRITORY TO NEW DIGGINGS

Dawson, Y.T., Aug. 19.—The Canadian Customs Department has waived the restrictions on American goods crossing the Yukon to the diggings at the strike on Chestna River in Alaska, near the head of White River. Such goods in transit will be allowed to pass without deposit, and where supervision is necessary to see that the goods are taken into the United States the expense of the same will be paid for by the Canadian Customs department.

This arrangement has been made on the recommendation of Commissioner Black and Dr. Alfred Thompson, M.P., and by the Hon. Mr. Hazen, Minister of Marine while in Dawson. No duty is being charged on Canadian goods being taken across the boundary to the new strike. Many are outfitting at Dawson, the nearest supply point.

Dr. D. D. Cairns, Dominion geologist, has just arrived at Dawson from the new camp and reports the strike rich and that the only feasible route is up the White River by steamer 90 miles to Donjek and thence by pack horse to the diggings, 60 miles. Large amounts of gold were being taken out when the party left camp. Dr. Cairns brought with him some splendid samples of nuggets and coarse gold and he reports the formation ideal for deposit placer gold and that the same extends to the Canadian side of the line.

Mr. George MacClean, controller for the Yukon, has been transferred to Ottawa, and Mr. G. A. Jeckell appointed to succeed him.

WHITE SLAVER CONFESSES HIS GUILT AFTER EVIDENCE IS IN

FORMER STATE ARCHITECT GUILTY ON FOUR COUNTS AND MAY GET A SENTENCE UNDER THE MANN ACT OF TWENTY YEARS

San Francisco, Aug. 22.—Maurice Diggs, former state architect, yesterday pleaded guilty to a violation of the Mann White Slave Act by eloping with two girls from Reno. He faces four counts and may get a sentence of twenty years.

A court room crowded from the railings to the doors listened in hushed expectancy yesterday when Marsha Warrington picked her way through the crowd to the witness stand and told how she was transported by the accused for immoral purposes from Sacramento to Reno, he leaving a wife and babies behind him.

Court adjourned with the story at the point where the party of four, consisting of Diggs, F. D. Caminetti, Marsha Warrington and Lola Norris stepped off the train at Reno.

The girl swore that Diggs had bought railway tickets and paid for the sleeping car drawing room they occupied. She swore she saw the tickets delivered to the conductor.

ARMED LUNATIC HAD A REIGN OF TERROR

Started Police and Citizens on a Cakewalk, Keeping Time With Gun.

Brooks, Alta., Aug. 18.—Because a local druggist refused his demand for cocaine, R. Vining, a young man employed in the camps around here, started a short lived reign of terror in Brooks last night.

Armed with two revolvers and his pockets bulging out with dynamite, he had the police and citizens doing a cakewalk for his edification.

Chief Hesketh seized him when he commenced his violence, but before he could reach his pockets the crazed man twisted himself away and pulled out two sticks of dynamite and threatened to give an imitation of a Kansas cyclone destruction.

For several hours he continued this performance and in his crazed and desperate state it would have been sheer foolhardiness to tamper with him.

He escaped but was captured this morning and will be sent up for trial.

Paris, Aug. 19.—The prefect of police, as a result of an inquiry, has suspended eight plain clothesmen of the 52nd division.

He has also censured and transferred Fauvel, whom he holds blameworthy of insufficient supervision. It is alleged that the policemen slipped pistols, knives and other stolen articles in the pockets of men they arrested.

H. Thumereau, a scene shifter at the Odeon, who was sentenced for carrying concealed weapons, declares that the knife found on him was placed in his pocket by a policeman. One Rosenfeld was condemned to thirteen months' imprisonment for theft of a pocket book which was put in his pocket by the police. The police made a mistake when they arrested the nephew of a politician and later a professor's son.
