

Ruling Families of British India United.

London, Aug. 25 .- Two of the most powerful native ruling families of British India were united! today when the Princess Indira, only daughter of the reigning Maharajah Gaekwar, of Boroda, was married to Prince Jitendra, son of the Maharajah of Cooch-Behar, after a romantic court-

The initial ceremony, which took place in the strictest privacy, was performed at the hotel where the princess has been staying, and was accompanied by the customary Hindu rites. Prior to the marriage the Princess Indira had been received into the Brahmanist faith, the creed of the bridegroom.

Subsequently the forms of a civil marriage were gone through at a registry office.

LONDON EMBASSY

American Diplomat Leases Official Residence.

London, Aug. 25 .- The American ambassador to the court of St. James, Walter H. Page, leased an official home today for three years. It is No. 5 Grosvenor Square and was selected after he had inspected many houses, most of which were offered at prohibitive prices.


