The latest from Sibolla is by no means comforting to those gentlemen who have been waiting on the results of somebody else's efforts in determining whether pay exists in the field, says the Telkwa Tribune. Leo McLaughlin and partner returned from there this week after driving their shaft 25 feet. They report the gravel at depth as carrying colors but no coarse or pay was in sight. This, the latest withdrawal from the field, means that the truth or falsity of the claims made for it will not be demonstrated this year as at this writing there is no one on the ground.

Andy Goodwill and Doyle were on their way in but have been forced to return on account of the depth of soft snow and lack of feed for the horses of their pack train. While by no means impossible it is likely that any of the "miners" who were so much in prominence recently in blanket staking the country on powers of attorney will venture this winter into the country, the ground presents an ideal place for winter development except for those totally paralysed in both arms. The weather at present is not conducive to camping under a tree while the grub-stake is being eaten up.

We can only hope that in the meantime none of them will go stone blind looking "down the trail" for Eastern capital to purchase their "interests" on the Sibolla.
