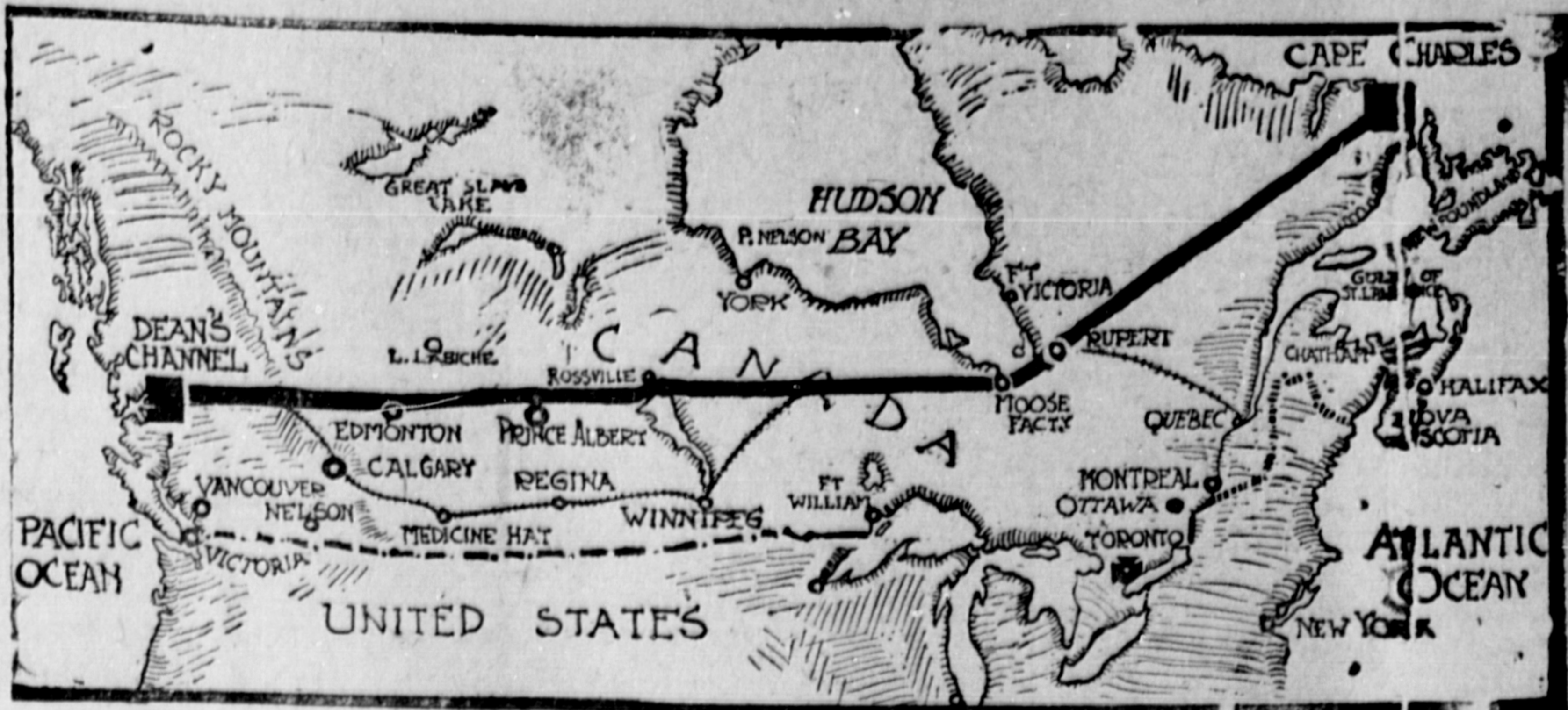

The line would be the farthest north of all the Canadian systems and the shortest. It is designed as part of an all-red service to circle the earth within the British Empire.

## GENERAL NEWS NOTES

More than 600,000 men are employed in working on the railways of the United Kingdom.

The Australian Government's surplus on the money invested in railways amounts to about 4 per cent per year.

Wisconsin's new law protecting frogs in their breeding season is believed to be the first of the kind in the world.

Olga Nethersole has been appointed a member of the English divorce reform committee by the British Government recently.

The Canadian Northern Railway will inaugurate its freight service into Calgary on January 1, it was announced by the board of trade.

Twenty-three million trees have been distributed by the forestry branch nursery station at Indian Head to the farmers on the western prairies.

Porridge will not be a feature of the morning meal of the citizens of Berlin, Ont., until the strike against the high price of milk is settled. The mayor is

at the head of a boycott to reduce the price of milk from 8 to 7 cents.

Now that Villa has become the central figure in the revolt against the Huerta government, it is being recalled that he was a professional cattle thief and cut-throat for a dozen years or so, a bandit on whose head there was a price.

Within the next year or two British Columbia will possess an up-to-date automobile highway extending from Kamloops to Tete Jaune Cache and giving connection through to Edmonton, says Hon. Thomas Taylor, minister of public works.

The court adhered to the view that a woman is not "a person within the meaning of the Solicitors Act of 1843."

The Bank of Montreal's annual report shows profits of \$2,648,402 for the year closing with October last, as compared with \$2,518,408 last year. A balance of \$802,813 was brought forward from preceding year and this with profits for the past year made a total of \$3,451,217 for distribution. Dividends at the rate of 10 per cent and bonuses of 2 per cent, amounted to \$1,920,000; deducting these and \$485,000 provision for bank premises leaves a balance of \$1,046,217.
