REDUCED INSURANCE RATES FOR RUPERT

Local Board Agents Have Been Fighting for Lower Insurance

The report of A. W. Ross, representing the B. C. Mainland Underwriters Association, who inspected the city on behalf of the board companies last summer, has just been received. It deals with all phases of the insurance problem, and in some instances the statements are not fairly put, and the recommendations are extreme. The book of ratings, however, has been revised and considerably lowered, which is the main feature.

The revision places the mercantile section on an average of 7 per cent., but as the rates are all specifically made on each building, it is impossible to get at the general percentage of reduction. The saving to premium payers, however, will be considerable.

This lowering of rates has been fought for by the local agents for some years and they are now beginning to accomplish results.
