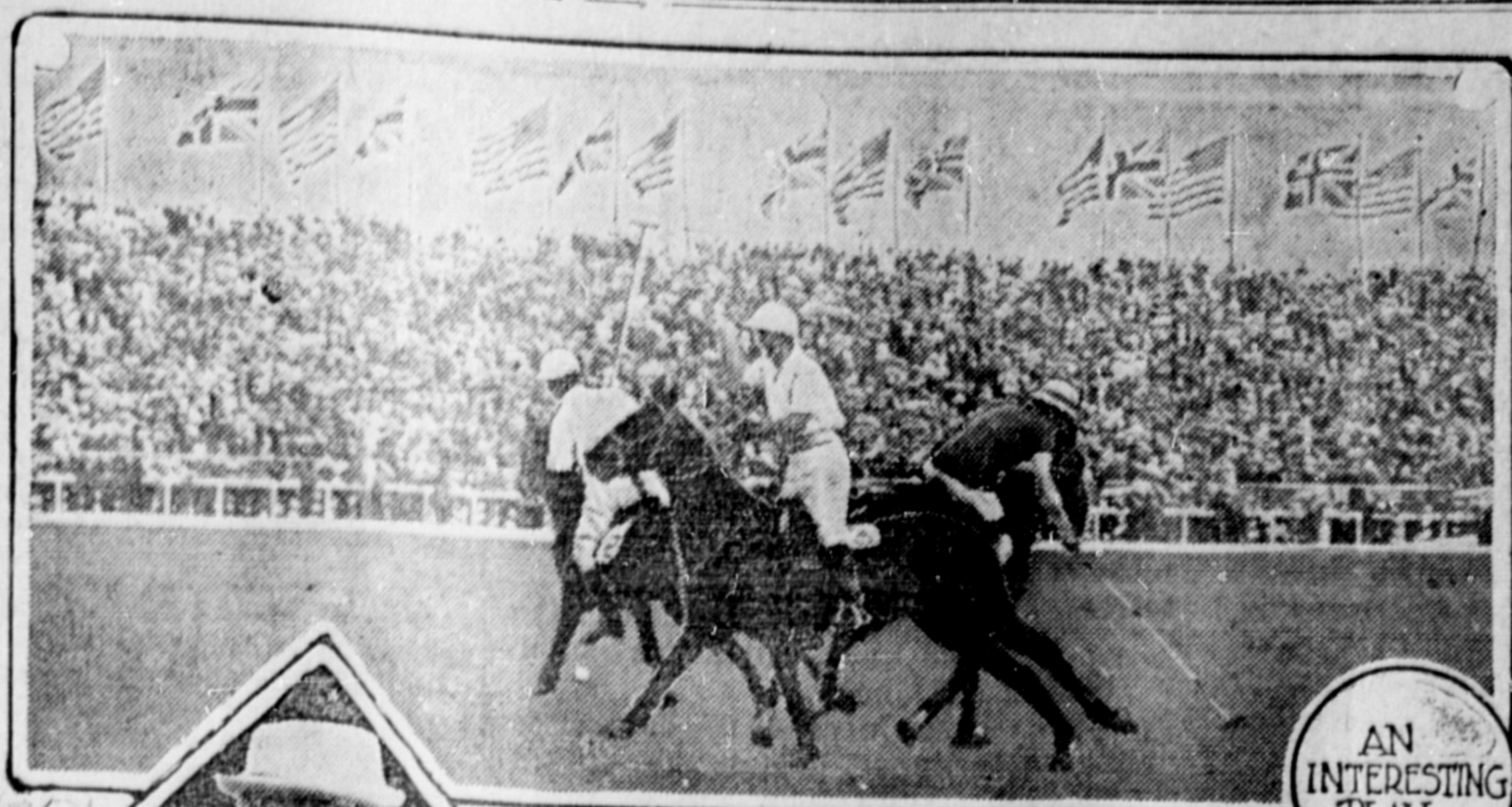

**GENERAL NEWS BRIEFLY TOLD**

**CANADIAN**  
 Berwick, N.S., has been invaded by swarms of rats. Breeders of poultry have had their eggs and chickens destroyed in large numbers.  
 Twenty-five buildings were destroyed by fire last Saturday in the village of Powassan, near North Bay, Ont. Sixteen families were made homeless and property worth \$300,000 was destroyed.  
 The Winnipeg City Council, last week, decided to send a telegram to Premier Borden urging him to put a check on immigration until better times and a more liberal expenditure of public money.  
 A heavy frost on Wednesday night of last week did much damage to the strawberry and apple blossoms in the Annapolis Val-

ley. The prospects for a large apple crop have been excellent.  
 A western paper states that the oil boom at Calgary is already responsible for the flotation of companies with a total capital stock of \$150,000,000, which is equal to three-fourths of the capital stock of the C. P. R.  
 All over the Province of Ontario, in cities, towns and in the country, the average salary of male teachers eight years ago was \$485, of females, \$335. Today these have been increased to \$788 and \$543 respectively.  
 The Nova Scotia Legislature was prorogued on Wednesday afternoon last by His Honor Lieutenant-Governor MacGregor. The session was the longest in the history of that Province, lasting about four months, and was

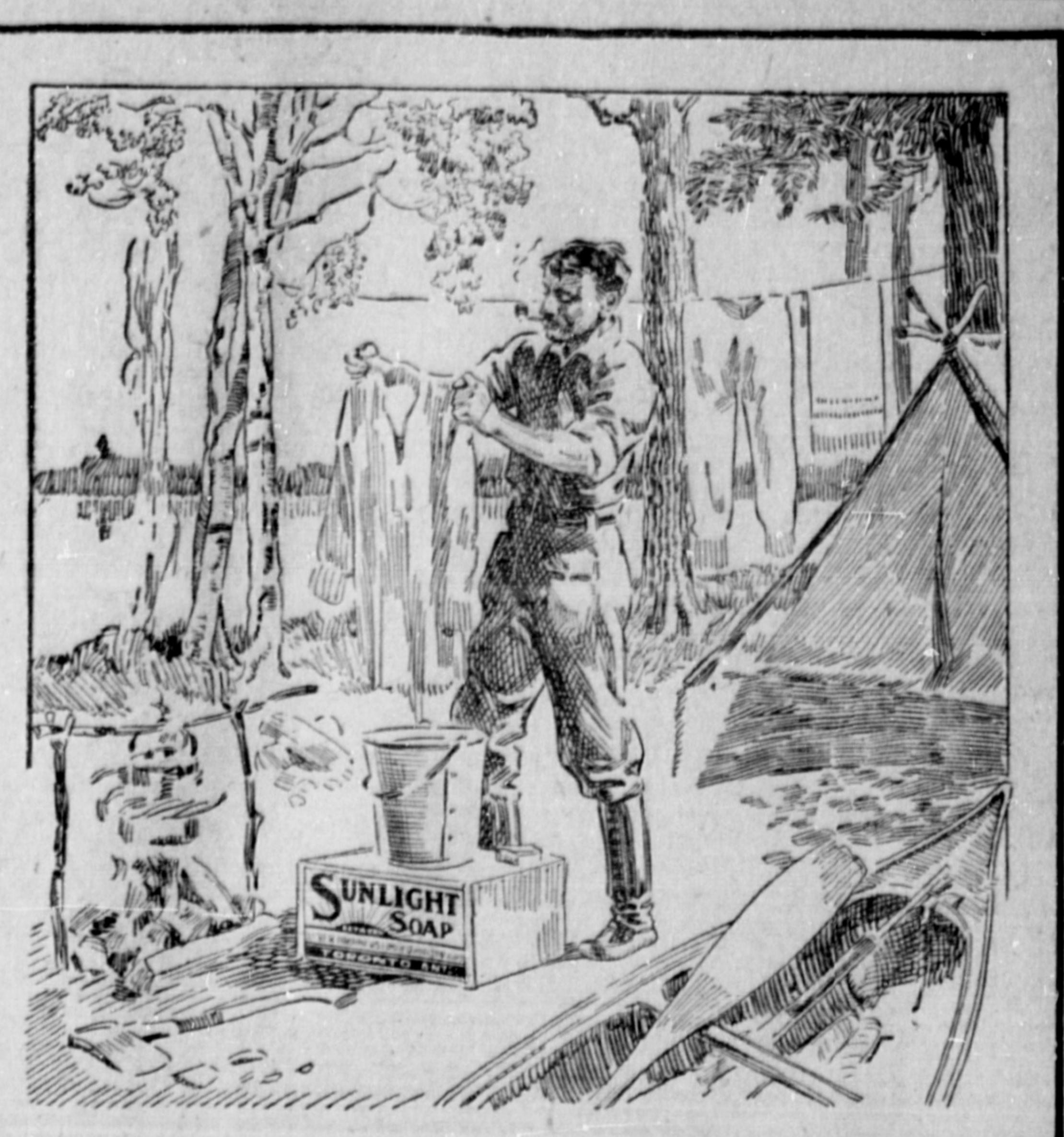
characterized by numerous and prolonged debates. One hundred and ninety bills, including a number of important Government measures were passed.  
**BRITISH AND FOREIGN**  
 The Panama Canal will probably be open for commercial use on July 1st.  
 There are now 176 aeroplanes owned by the War Department, and of these all but forty are of British make.  
 The Chaplin, Milne, Grenfell Company, an old aristocratic banking company in London, Eng., has suspended payment, with liabilities of twenty-five million dollars.  
 William Sulzer, who was recently deprived of his office as governor of New York, by im-

peachment, has formally announced that he will be an independent candidate for the gubernatorial nomination.  
 A New York physician prints the statistics of alcohol as a cause of insanity and epilepsy on every prescription blank that he uses. He suggests that merchants, department stores, druggists, and so forth might be willing to have them on their wrapping paper.  
 At a recent memorial banquet to Wilbur Wright, Colonel Seely said that he had had the stability of the aeroplane proved to him recently. A pilot flew with him to a height of 2,000 feet and abandoned control. The machine banked and resumed its level flight and righted itself. He believed that something similar had been done in Germany and France.  
 Lady Bryce told the conference of the Women's National Liberal Association that after an absence of seven years she seemed to have come back to a new England. There seemed to be a more widespread interest in all sorts of social questions; people recognized better the value of personal service. "But one thing that has struck me with great concern is the lessening of respect for law and order."

It is stated in political circles that Sir Edward Grey has notified President Wilson in friendly but unequivocal terms that if, as a consequence of his persistent backing of General Villa, that bandit should eventually become President of Mexico, the British Government will demand and expect satisfaction for the murder of Mr. Benson, the British subject, who was done to death, "either by Villa himself or with his connivance."

Submarine wireless telephony and telegraphy were publicly demonstrated for the first time last week in Boston. Conversation between men stationed on boats moored 150 feet away at the Boston lightship was carried on with natural ease and in ordinary tones, and messages in the Morse code were transmitted without interruption between the same craft separated one, five and ten miles on the surface of a choppy sea.

The first aerial sham battle in the history of the world probably will be fought over Salisbury Plain within a few days. The greatest assemblage of military aerial craft is now gathering for the manoeuvres, there being nearly a hundred aeroplanes and seven hundred pilots and mechanics of the Royal Flying Corps encamped there. The details of the plans are being kept secret. The camp is at a remote place on the vast plain, and is guarded by sentries armed with revolvers.
