Portland, July 13.—Upon the result of the count of the referendum vote cast by forty-five local unions along the Pacific Coast from Juneau to San Diego, relative to the action for a uniform wage scale, depends largely whether a general strike shall be declared or not by the longshoremen. The count of the vote which was taken in accordance with a resolution passed recently at the Pacific Coast district convention of the International Longshoremen's Association at Vancouver, B.C., will be begun here today by the executive committee.
