

It will be noticed with great regret that at one or two Conservative ward meetings certain speakers have taken advantage of the European catastrophe to make party capital out of a world's misfortune. This tendency is to be most strongly deprecated. It does absolutely no good to argue now who was right and who was wrong. Our own views on the subject are well known, but it would be stupid to reiterate them at such a time. We Canadians, Liberals and Conservatives, all stand together shoulder to shoulder in this business. If one party has been wrong and the other right this is no time to say so.
