A late issue of Colliers calls upon the American people to become savers instead of borrowers. A table showing the percentage among the nations of those who save put the United States at the bottom of the ·list, with only ninety-nine savers out of every thousand. Incidentally, it might be pointed out that Canada did not appear at all, since no doubt the percentage of savers was still smaller. This, of course, does not mean all Americans and Canadians are spendthrifts. Itis rather because this being a new country a large proportion of the people are investors and prefer the profits of buying and selling to the trifling amount that comes from interest at bank rates.

There is a large class, however, who do not use their money for any profitable purpose but let it go as fast as it comes. A large number of workingmen are of this type. They say it takes every cent they earn to keep them going and no doubt it does. But that is because no method is emploed. No matter what the income, a man can easily get away with it if he wishes. 
