EDITORIALS

The latest election report is that the Bob Rogers faction will force a Dominion election on in February. It is recognized on every hand that it would have been held this fall were it not that the Duke absolutely refused to dissolve the House. Ever since war was declared rumors of an election have been afloat in Canada and the Liberals all over the country protested. They did this on patriotic grounds. They contended that with all our resources in money and men having been placed at the disposal of the Empire it was not fitting to start a local fight over what is really only a petty issue in proportion to the business of the Empire.

Perhaps Conservatives are under the impression that the existence of a world-wide war would favor their re-election. Perhaps they even think that the Liberals are so patriotic that they would let the whole country go by acclamation. This is expecting a little too much. While the Liberals no doubt would be willing to allow the present government to conduct affairs through crisis even after their term of office had expired it is unreasonable to suppose that they would allow them another term of office without a fight. That the chances for the Liberals are good is evidenced by "the analogy shown us in the United States. 
