Paris, Feb. 27.-Following the decision of the English, French, and Russian Ministers of Finance that the Allies shall pool their resources for the conduct of the war, the French Minister of Finance removed the embargo off all French exportations so far as the allied nations and the United States are concerned. The latter nation is the only neutral nation thus favored and this action is declared to be in recognition of the extreme friendliness between France and the United States.
