Grand Jury Probe Likely to Be Followed by Drastic Action-Tramp Steamers Chief Offenders.

New York, March 9. — Behind the Federal Grand Jury investigation, in progress here to determine if there has been a systematic violation of American neutrality and customs law, there is said to lie a determination by the United States government to make effective its stand against detention of any American vessel by a belligerent power on a suspicion that contraband is in the cargo.
