

#### FOE FAILS TO PAY LOAN.

Bulgaria Wanted.

Paris, April 20 .- Germany has 75c. failed to pay to Bulgaria the portion of the loan she agreed to remit April 1, according to a Sofia special to the Petit Parisien, which says it is believed Germany distrusts the Bulgarian attitude and suspects she already has decided to join the Allies.

When it was announced in February that negotiations had been completed for a loan of \$30,000,-000 to Bulgaria by German and Austrian bankers it was stated that no political conditions were attached to the arrangement, but it was regarded as significant that Bulgaria had refused the proffer of a similar loan made several months before by the powers of the Triple Entente.
