## NO DECISION IS YET REACHED ON GENERAL ELECTION FOR CANADA

Ottawa, May 2.—The matter of a general election is still undecided. The report that steps were being taken to send forward the ballots and affidavit forms to be used by the soldiers in the event of a vote being taken is confirmed by the presence in the corridors of the House of Commons of large cases containing the papers necessary for the taking of the vote. The great majority of these cases are addressed to the High Commissioner's office in London.

But some are being sent to Bermuda, where one regiment of Canadians is being kept in garrison. The sending forward of these papers does not necessarily mean a June election, as they could be held for months if necessary. The Evening Citizen, dealing in its news column with election prospects, says: "No announcement is yet made as to a general election. The absorbing character of events abroad affects the political situation and makes dissolution in the immediate future much less likely than was the case heretofore. The matter, however, is still undecided."
