

AMAZING MARCHES.

The swiftness of the present Russian advance is in keeping with their traditions for good & money. B. C. MILK marching, as exemplified in the REDUCE THE HIGH COST of Tiving long journey of Suvaroff's army from Russia to Italy in 1799, and of Kutusoff's forces during the invasion of 1812. In this, as in other matters of warfare, however, the record seems to be with Napoleon. In 1805 he crossed the Rhine on September 26, was in Vienna on November 13, and on December 2 crushed the united armies of Russia and Austria at Austerlitz. Almost incredibly swift was Napoleon's swoop on Prussia in the following year, when, crossing the Saale on October 9, he defeated Hohenlohe's army at Jena on the 14th, and was in Berlin on the 25th, with all Prussia at his feet. Three years later he broke even these records by returning from France to Spain on April 17, rushing to the Austrian frontier, defeating the enemy five times in as many days, and entering Vienna on May 13.—Ex.
