or 6,400 acres, out of the frag-
mentary bits left over for the
pre-emptor, in the whole of the
Bulkley Valley.

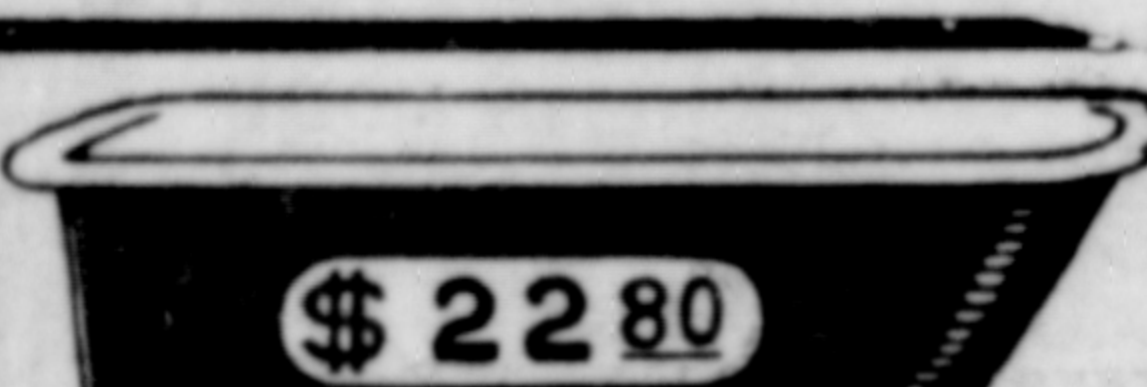
And those fragments were situ-
ated so far back from the rail-
way that it would be impos-
sible to farm them profitably. The bulk
of the land in that district, as in
the Skeena, Nechaco and other
valleys, has been taken up by the
syndicate and the professional
speculator. The land is being
held for prices which prevented
settlement and production. The
words of a railway traffic man
not long ago were: "At the sta-
tions through the interior, be-
tween here and Fort George,
there is not enough traffic to pay
us to stop one freight train." The
freight trains, as well as the pas-
senger trains, make their stops,
however, and they lose money
each and every time.

As was said in a previous let-
ter from Vancouver, the issue has

ceased to be one of party poli-
tics. In the interior valleys the
few settlers living there have
been wholly dependent upon the
government for a livelihood. Road
work has been carried on in frag-
mentary pieces, as part of that
system of peonage which was de-
scribed by the man in Prince Rup-
ert. The roads have led now-
where and have not developed the
country or helped the interior
settler to help himself. Now
there is no money to use for road
work and the dependent in the
valleys is also beginning to see
through the obscurity of his sur-
roundings to the real state of af-
fairs.

Even though a general realiza-
tion of these things in British
Columbia brings about a defeat of
the present government and the
introduction of saner methods, it
will take a new government years
to adjust the difficulties that have
accumulated about the rulers of
this province in the last decade.

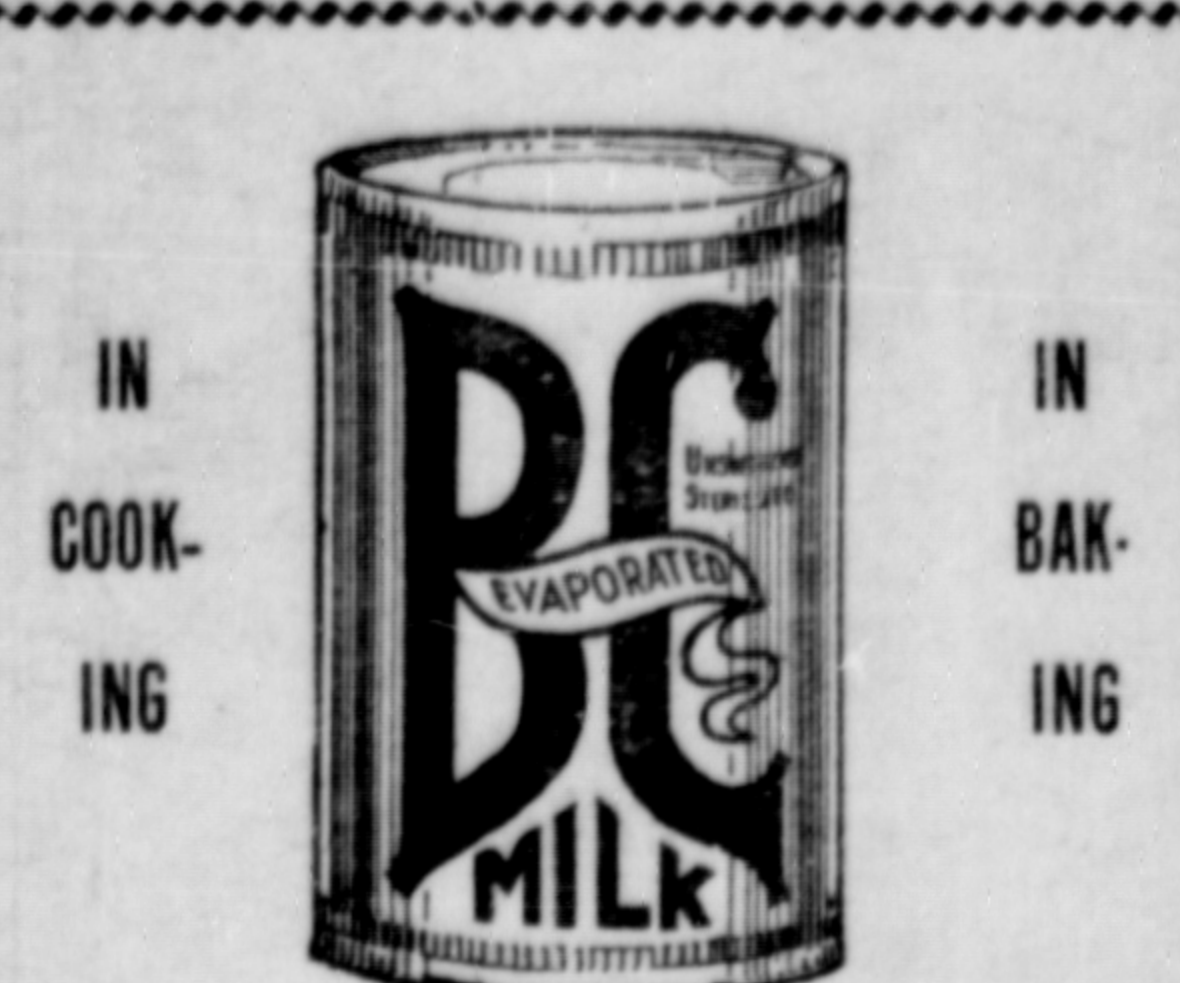
