RETREATING RUSSIANS DESTROY OIL WELLS

Berlin, June 5.—News from the
Galician front concerning the re-
treat of the Russians indicate that
they fired and destroyed twenty or
more great crude oil wells as well
as a number of wells from which
naphtha is derived in the oil-pro-
ducing region between Boryslaw
and Dropodycz lying to the west
of Stryj. It is estimated that 80,-
000 tons of oil was destroyed.

Although the fires have been
brought under control by the Aus-
trian and German troops, the
whole territory is covered with a
pall of smoke.

The Russians had been using
the wells for the production of
illuminating oil, benzine and
grease. They are said to have
spared the English and French
wells.

SIR GEORGE PERLEY TO REMAIN IN LONDON

Ottawa, June 5.—The report
that Sir George Perley, acting
high commissioner in London,
has been recalled, is denied in
government circles here. It will
be recalled that Sir Robert Bor-
den, in replying to a question in
the House last session, intimated
that Sir George probably would
remain in London until the close
of the war. There is no reason
to believe that Sir Robert Borden
has changed his mind in regard
to Canada's representative in
Great Britain.

SMALLEST STATE IN EUROPE JOINS ALLIES

Rome, June 5.—San Marino
Thursday declared war against
Austria-Hungary.

The latest enemy of the Teu-
tonic allies is an independent
state or principality, the smallest
in Europe, located almost due east
from Florence, in the southern
and east part of the province of
Emilia, Italy. It has a population
of 10,791, and an army of 950
men at full war strength.
