#### CONFEDERATE VETERANS PLEDGE WILSON LOYALTY

Richmond, Va., June 9 .- Thousands of Confederate veterans at the opening of their twenty-fifth reunion here on Tuesday cheered the hope expressed by their leaders that peace in America may not be disturbed by war in Europe. They reiterated their loyalty to the Union, shouted pledges of support to the President in any crisis and bowed assent to prayers that those who guide the Republic' destinies might be blessed with wisdom to deal with pending in- 2 ternational affairs.

Frequent references to the European war were made at the convention of the United Sons of Confederate Veterans, who cheered a pledge of support to the President in upholding the nation's honor. Tributes were expressed to Jefferson Davis, Robt. E. Lee, Stonewall Jackson and other Confederate leaders, among them Gen. E. J. B. Stuart, whose widow appeared on the platform and received an ovation.

The Southern posts were welcomed to Richmond by Governor Stuart and Judge D. G. Tyler, who spoke in behalf of Virginia vet- 2 erans. Judge Tyler, a son of President Tyler, compared the Confederacy to Belgium. S. Elliot, of the Digby wireless




