Amundsen's Ship Fast in the Ice

Capt. Hecla was also Icebound in Fishing Boat, but Managed to Get Free Carrying the News to Nome

NOME, Sept. 17 .- Amundsen's expedition ship Maud, which left two months ago bound for the North Pole, has been caught in the ice 20 miles off Cape Serge on the Siberian coast, according to information brought by Captain Hecla, whose fishing boat is also icebound near the Maud.

Captain Hecla's vessel, being of light draft, wormed her way out after being icebound for ten days, but Amundsen's ship was still fast when the fishing boat left.

Amundsen had hopes of being able to free the Maud soon and continue his voyage.
