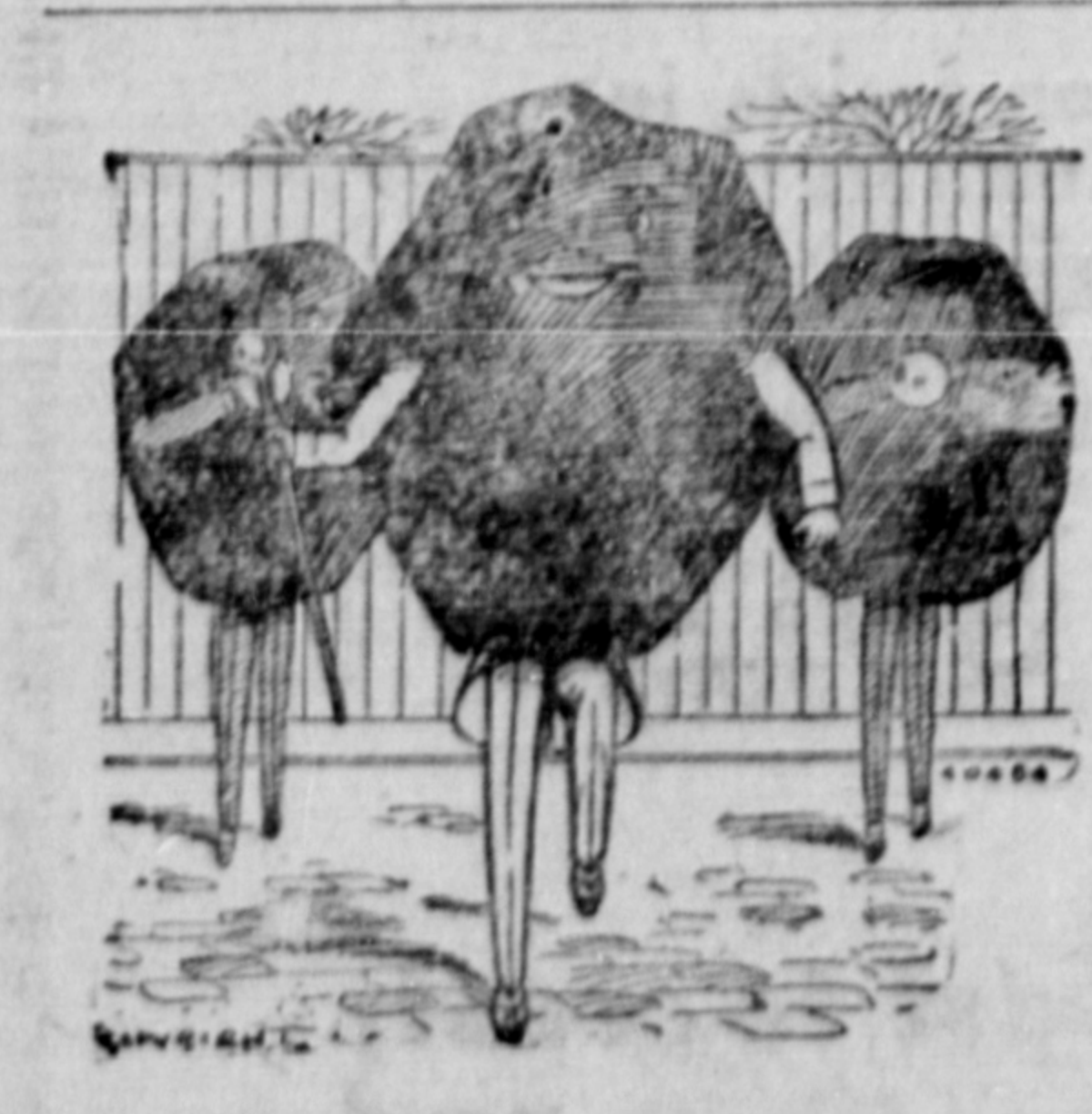

WATER NOTICE.

Take notice that The Maritime Fisheries, Limited, whose address is care of Messrs. Fairmore & Fulton, Prince Rupert, B. C., will apply for a licence for storage of 227,000 cubic feet of water out of a mountain stream, also known as Point Nowich Creek, which flows southerly and drains into the Skeena River, about northwest corner of Lot 4445, Range 5, Coast District.
The storage dam will be located at about 100 feet from easterly boundary of Lot 29, Range 5, Coast District.
The capacity of the reservoir to be created is about 227,000 cubic feet, and it will flood about 1,210 acres of land. The lot is a point as authorized by conditional licence No. 3705, as amended, and will be used for industrial purpose upon the land described as sub-lot 4, District Lot No. 4445, Range 5, Coast District.
The licence applicant is to supplement a right to take and use water as per conditional licence No. 3705, as amended.
