The Board also exceeded its authority. After the hearing Premier Meighen instantly declared the suspension of the sugar order permanent.

WINNIPEG, Oct. 21.—The annulment of mixed marriages by the courts of Quebec was denounced as illegal and a menace to the moral life of the nation, in a resolution adopted by the council for social service of the Church of England in Canada.
