### JAPANESE INCREASE IN STATE OF CALIFORNIA

One Child of Every 13 Born is from Nippon

SAN FRANCISCO, October 26.—The Japanese population of California gained from 1910-1919 almost as much by birth as by immigration. The figures are: Net increase by immigration, 25,592; net increase by birth, 20,331. In the years 1910-1919 the total number of Japanese births in California was 28,037. The progressive annual increase is shown by the fact that whereas in 1910 the Japanese births numbered 719, in the year 1919 the Japanese births numbered 4,378. Putting it in another way, the ratio of Japanese births to all births in 1910 was 2.25 per cent.; in 1919 it was 7.82 per cent. That is to say, in 1910 one out of every 44 children born in California was a Japanese, while in 1919 one out of every 13 children born was a Japanese. Of course, in the agricultural sections, where the Japanese have colonized, the Japanese birth rate bulks even more prominently. In the rural parts of Sacramento county 49 per cent. of all birth in 1919 were Japanese. The alarm which Californians feel regarding the situation is typified by this comment of The Los-Angeles Times: "If the present birth ratio were maintained for the next ten years there would be 150,000 children of Japanese descent born in California in 1929 and but 40,000 white children. And in 1949 the majority of the population of California would be Japanese, ruling the State."

### ITALIANS WILL DROP HYPHEN

People from Sunny Southern Europe Want to Become Citizens of Canada

TORONTO, Oct. 27.—Toronto Italians are going to drop the hyphen. From now on they want to be called Canadians and no longer Italian-Canadians. This decision was reached at a meeting of the Italo-Canadian Educational and Political League.

"The first item on the program of the League is to have all Italian immigrants become Canadians, who will fully discharge their duties as Canadian citizens," was the statement of Cesare Gallasso, President of the Italian People's Journal.

Organizer Nanni Oranova expressed the opinion that Canada should look after the second and third generations of the Italian population and take care that they have their own desires filled to become good Canadian citizens.

### Attached to Home Land

"With the older people it is a difficult matter; they are strange to the English language, the laws and customs of this country, and, moreover, they have a certain attachment to the mother country which the younger generation has not," said Mr. Oranova.

"We who have become Canadian citizens in the past are opposed to any force which would destroy the good qualities which our Italian immigrants bring with them," he continued. "It is well known that the Italians are thrifty, supremely honest, thoroughly religious and moral. I speak of the great majority, not of the exception."

### Italy Can Contribute

"The melting pot must be for all; the Canadian must be thrown in, too; the making of Canadian citizens must be unobtrusive; it must come from within. In the process of becoming Canadian citizens, for which they are all so eager, it is to be hoped they will contribute something of the indomitable courage that has carried Italy through the triumphs and reverses, the moral revolutions and the material changes of 25 centuries," continued Mr. Oranova.

"Italians in this city want to become citizens, and, in fact, all over the Dominion there is a movement on foot to take out naturalization papers and share with the citizens of this country not only the rights and privileges, but also the responsibilities and burdens of the country."
