



**RECORD TIME ON CONTRACT**

Four Candidates Meet on Every Platform Nightly and Manson's Prospects Look Good

**MANSON IS REFUSED REPLY AT FRANCOIS**

BURNS LAKE, Nov. 22.—The campaign waxes fast and furious. Joint meetings are held at which all four candidates are present.

At Francois Lake Friday evening the biggest meeting in the history of the place was held. It was Manson against the field. Kelly refused to allow Manson to reply, so the meeting adjourned and a new public meeting was held immediately, lasting until midnight.

The indications are good for Manson's election. Prudhomme's claim as an independent and farmer is met by the fact that the oldest and best settlers signed their names to Manson's nomination papers.

Murray finds the anti-Bowser feeling still strong and that injures his cause. The people do not want to return to a Bowser regime.

Kelly, the labor man, is a serious factor in the election, and roads are the chief issue in the campaign.
