**Land Act Amendments**  
Synopsis of

**PRE-EMPTORS' FREE GRANTS ACT.**  
The scope of this Act is enlarged to include all persons joining and serving with the Majesty's Forces. The time within which the heirs or devisees of a deceased pre-emptor may apply for title under this Act is extended from one year from the death of such person, as formerly, until one year after the conclusion of the present war. This privilege is also made retroactive.  
No fees relating to pre-emptions are due or payable by soldiers on pre-emptions recorded after June 26, 1912. Taxes are remitted for five years. Provision for return of moneys accrued, due and been paid since August 4, 1914, on account of payments, fees or taxes on soldiers' pre-emptions.  
Interest on agreements to purchase land, and taxes, and taxes, remitted from direct or indirect, remitted from settlement to March 21, 1920.  
**SUB-PURCHASERS OF CROWN LANDS.**  
Provision made for issuance of Crown grants to sub-purchasers of Crown lands, acquiring rights from purchasers who failed to complete purchase, involving forfeiture, or fulfillment of conditions of purchase, interest and taxes. Where sub-purchasers do not claim whole of original parcel, purchase price due and taxes may be distributed proportionately over whole area. Applications must be made by May 1, 1920.  
**GRAZING.**  
Grazing Act, 1913, for systematic development of livestock industry provides for grazing districts and range administration under commission. Annual grazing permits issued based on numbers raised; priority for established owners. Stock-owners may form Associations for range management. Free, or partially free, permits for settlers, campers or travellers, to be issued.
