IT'S A SHAME SAY PEOPLE

Way in Which G. T. P. Treated is Subject of Constant Remark; Ottawa Rumor.

A special despatch to the Vancouver Province from Ottawa intimates the possibility of President Hanna and other heads of the Canadian National Railway retiring and the control of the system passing to the heads of the Grand Trunk. It cites the difficulties with the employees and suggests that when the arbitration is concluded the whole question of management will come up for consideration, and that there may be a fresh start.

This suggestion is denied officially by the Canadian Press who say "There is not a word of truth in the story."

Other rumors have come through to Prince Rupert from time to time regarding the general dissatisfaction caused by the placing of the G. T. P. in absolute control of the C. N. R., the G. T. P. officials in almost every case being subordinated to the C. N. R.

"It's a shame," accompanied by swear words, is the chief expletive used in connection with the manner in which the Prince Rupert branch of the system has been treated under the reorganization.
