### CONSUL SPEAKS ON BRITISH AFRICA

Boers are the Majority of White Population and Conserve Their Position.

In his address to the men's banquet at the Anglican Church Wednesday night E. A. Wakefield, American Consul, gave a most enlightening talk on British South Africa. He gave as his opinion that it was a good thing there was a Boer at the head of affairs when war broke out as the Boers volunteered for service in large numbers, not only fort service in South Africa but for Flanders.

The late General Botha and Premier Smuts were both capable men. South Africa has progressed under Smuts as never before. The population of the country would be large but for the policy of discouraging immigration. The Boers were in the majority among the white population of the country, and they proposed to continue in the majority.

The chief drawback to progress in South Africa was the drought and it was thought to be still drying up. In some parts of the colony they had only 2 inches of rain a year while it was not uncommon in some districts to have a whole year without any rain.

Mr. Wakefield spoke of the ostrich farms, the vineyards, the diamond fields, the gold mines, the beauty of the scenery, the black population and was enthusiastic over the country as one of wonderful surprises.


