

### FIR TREE SUGAR

e American Forestry Magazine Speaks of Discovery of Professor Davidson.

(Special via G. f. P. Telegraphs.)

WASHINGTON, Feb. 17.—The merican Forestry Magazine has an account of the growth of sugar on British Columbia fir, said to be of great value to chemstry, came as the result of investigations of Professor Davidson, chief of the botanical repartment of the University of British Columbia at Vancouver. A specimen of the product upon analysis is said to have indicated the presence of a large percentage of an extremely rare variety of sugar.

While fir sugar is not expected to become a factor in the food supply like the product of the Canadian beet, the article advances the belief that it will prove useful. Indians have made use of the sugar for many years.
