## TRICK ARTIST MAKES WAGER

Will Forfeit \$50 to the General Hospital if He Fails to Make Good.

Cecil Barrie, the trick artist at the Westholme, has accepted a challenge to get out of his "mystery box" under a wager with Mr. Hunt of this city. Last night on the platform he promised to forfeit \$50 which should go to the local hospital in case he failed to make good. Mr. Hunt is to use thirty feet of his own rope to tie up the trunk which will also be locked in six places. Then Professor Barrie is to have irons on his ankles and wrists and his hands will be handcuffed to his ankles before he is put in the trunk. People are wondering if he will get out. This is Cecil Barrie's last night in town and no one, who is fond of conjuring tricks, should fail to see him.
