**EGYPTIANS ARE HUNGRY BECAUSE SOWED COTTON**

Plowed Up Their Wheat in Order to Secure the Big Prices.

(Special via U. T. P. Telegraphs.)

LONDON, March 9.—The food crisis in Egypt has been caused by the land owners, including the land owning peasantry, increasing the area planted in cotton so as to take advantage of the prices in cotton, according to the Daily Mail's Cairo correspondent.

Wheat and other cereals were actually plowed up when approaching maturity in order to sow cotton. The cotton area is now nearly 25 per cent greater than before the war.

Normally Egypt feeds herself, but in view of the present shortage of cereals there is greater danger of the famishing people being stirred to rioting.

**LEVEL CROSSING OVER RAILROAD**

Would Make Access to Government Wharf More Convenient, Cheaper and Safer.

IMPROVEMENTS TO WHARF DEPEND ON NEW ROADWAY

The provincial government intends to make drastic improvements and extensions at the Government wharf this season, but all these changes will be dependent on whether the plan for a level crossing at Cow Bay is allowed by the Railway Commission or not. These improvements will include repiling of the wharf, which is now in a bad condition and the dock will be put in first class shape.

The new crossing at Cow Bay will allow much better access to the dock and will eliminate the high cost of maintaining Manson Way for that overhead crossing will be torn down altogether. The new route will be down Third Avenue, crossing Cow Bay and a branch would then go to the dry dock and the government dock.

The road to the government wharf would branch immediately the tracks are crossed and would follow the railway tracks to the wharf beneath the present overhead. The new roadway would make the removal of the present overhead imperative.

The fear was expressed at last night's council meeting that the new road would block the city's entrance to Cow Bay but the local government officials say that this would be hindered very little by the new work.

**WHALING COMPANY IS FORMED AT VICTORIA**

Will Manufacture Fertilizer From Fish Offal and Catch Whales.

VICTORIA, March 9.—With a capital of \$690,000 the Vancouver Island Whaling Co. has been formed to carry on whaling on the British Columbia coast and to manufacture fertilizer from fish offal.

Returned soldiers will be employed wherever possible.

The plant will be established on Barkley Sound. Options have already been secured on vessels and whaling will start this summer.

**DOPE INCREASES**

To the Editor.—For the purpose of correcting the erroneous statements which from time to time have been made by the opponents of reform to the effect that the tide of prohibition that has swept over the Dominion has had its back-wash in an increased consumption of narcotic drugs, allow me to give the official figures from the Department of Health.

January, 1920. The figures in the first column following show imports into Canada for consumption during the fiscal year ending March 31st, and in the second column for the six months ending November 30, 1919.

Cocaine, oz. .... 12,333 3,293  
Morphine, oz. .... 30,087 9,424  
Crude Opium, lbs., 34,263 7,222

In this connection an official of the Department of Health points out that the figures included those from for June 1919, when the Department had just taken over from the Board of Commerce, consequently they had no control during that month, as the great majority of the dealers' supplies were already in Canada or on the way to Canada. A more correct comparison of the enormous reduction is to take the figures for the quarter ending October 30, when the total supply for consumption was 1,100 lbs., as compared with 8,500 lbs. for the corresponding period of the preceding year.
