#### Four-Hour Game.

The game at Boston last Saturday when the Boston and Brooklyn Nationals played to a 1-1 draw in 26 innings was one of the most remarkable games in baseball history, and established the long game record for both big leagues. The previous record was hung up by Philadelphia and Boston of the American League on September, 1, 1916, when the clubs went 24 innings, Philadelphia winning 4 to 1. The National League record was established-August 22, 1917, when Brooklyn beat Pittsburg 6 to 5, in 22 innings. The box heroes of the latest record game were Joe Oeschger and Leon Cadore who were both going strong when darkness ended the fray. Both teams fielded excellently behind their boxmen in the game which lasted 10 minutes short of four hours.
