

### CIGARETTE SMOKING BY WOMEN BANNED

adoption of a pledge against cigarette smoking by members of girls' organizations throughout Canada as proposed by Mrs. Greene, president of the London, Ont., W.C.T.U., is arousing considerable interest among the workers who are endeavoring to devise some means to check the alarming development of the habit in the Dominion.

"The W. C. T. U. has had the matter of cigarette smoking mong girls and women under advisement for some time, and recently a controversy has been waged in which numerous women have defended the practice on the ground that it is a nerve-soothing diversion and that it should not he restricted for the pleasure of men alone," said Mrs. Greene.

"The growing habit of eigarette smoking among young girls will undoubtedly increase with the arrival of immigrants from the Old Land, whehe it is already firmly established. I should like to suggest that the young people's organizations of the city should have a pledge of all girls promising abstinence from the smoking of cigarettes."

Mrs. Greene declares that she is developing the belief that more! can be done to check intemperance by education than can be accomplished by legislation. An effort to undertake an educational campaign will be made through teen age girls'organizations and through the mothers' clubs.
