There will be at least five considerable changes in taxation in England:

1. A complete recasting of the Income-tax, giving more relief for the married and imposing heavier penalties for evasion.

2. A higher scale of taxation for motor vehicles, together with the

dropping of the petrol tax. 3. An increase of the duty upon imported wines, which have not been taxed so heavily since the war as beer and spirits.

4. Higher postal rates. 5. A solution of the problem of the Excess Profits Tax, which now stands at 40 per cent.


