"But one of the first things he did was to advise the Government that he wanted to go to Ottawa to get pointers on the Dominion Railway Board. I replied to him. in writing that if he did we would only be acknowledging that we had appointed to the position a man who knew so little about the office that he had to go east for instructions.

"But in spite of orders Major Retailack went east. Of course the Government properly refused to pay his travelling expenses, which were the travelling expenses incurred by a man defying the instructions of the Government. Instructions of the Government to inquire into things in Vancouver he defied, and instead went east. Naturally we refused to pay his expenses. These are the bills he says the Government will not pay.

Salary Question.
