

50,000 BOTTLES OF

million Dollars.

DETROIT, May 24 .- Information leading to knowledge of the whereabouts of 50,000 quarts of whiskey and other liquors hidden along the Detroit River between Detroit and Trenton is said to have been gained by Federal prohibition agents.

Such a quantity of liquor, at present prices, would be worth at least half a million dollars.

Conducting a secret investigation today, agents of the Government questioned men believed to have knowledge of the whiskeysmuggling industry, forcing them to tell where the liquor was cached.
