NOTICE

Pursuant to Bylaw 255 governing above, also resolution of Council dated July 12th. All licences are due and payable on July 15th, 1915, and must be paid forthwith. Section 33 of this Bylaw provides the following:

"Any person guilty of a breach of this Pursuant to an order of His Honor Judge bylaw, or who carries on any profession, trade, occupation or calling, for which a licence or tax is provided for in this bylaw, without having first taken out such licence and having paid the licence fee or tax herein provided, shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) together with the amount of the licence fee or tax, which should have been paid, and in default of payment, to imprisonment for sixty (60)

The Bylaw also declares:




