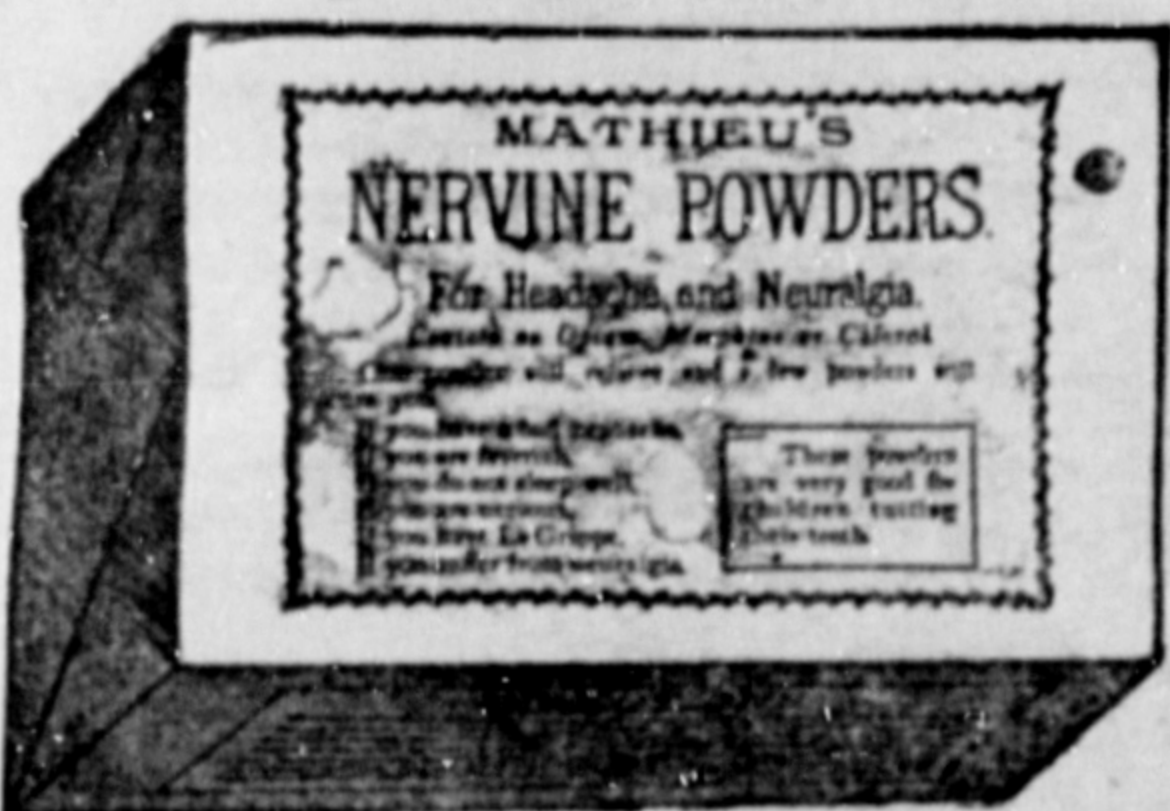

ANOTHER LUSITANIA VICTIM'S BODY FOUND

London, July 23.—A body supposed to be that of Lindon W. Bates, jr., of New York, who lost his life on the Lusitania, has been washed ashore on the Limerick coast. A telegram to that effect was received today from Wesley Frost, the American consul at Queenstown, by Newton B. Knox, an American mining engineer and friend of Mr. Bates. The telegram says a gold watch and a gold cigarette case marked with Mr. Bates' monogram were found on the body. Measurements of the body also indicate that the identification is correct.
