SHAWATLANS PIPELINE REQUIRES SUPPORTS

A report from the light superintendent to the city council last night drew attention to the necessity for making the 45-inch pipeline at Shawatlangs more secure.

The mayor expressed surprise at such a report, as the late city engineer reported before he left that everything was in good shape. He suggested that the matter be held over until the members of the council could investigate.

Ald. Kerr stated that the pipeline had always been more or less in bad shape, but that the securing of it would not cost much, as the patrolman could do most of the work.

Ald. Maitland explained that the ground was frozen when the pipe was laid, and that some of the supports had sunk. He pointed out that concrete abutments were required at some of the valves.

Ald. Nicoll said that Mr. Mason had told him three or four months ago that new supports would have to be put in place soon.
