(Continued From Page Two.) and that when a nation broke through the laws and conventions of society it had to be driven out.

The speaker went on to trace the progress of the war from the turning point at the Marne up to the holding up of the Germans outside of Warsaw. He expressed the firm belief that Germany had reached the zenith of her military power and was now on the downgrade, while the Allies gathered strength. He dwelt at length on the magnificent work done by the Canadians, Australians, New Zealanders, Indians and South Africans, his references to the work of Louis Botha calling forth great cheering, as also did his request that Canada send 300,000 men instead of 150,000.

Upon resuming his seat, the speaker was given a great ovation. It was a great speech, worthy of a great occasion, but one which cold print could never do justice to, as it could not reproduce the soldierly spirit and patriotic fervor which fired it. One could just imagine Mr. Grant leading a company of highlanders to the charge.

The following resolution was submitted by the mayor, and, needless to say, carried unanimously:

Resolved—That, on this anniversary of the declaration of a righteous war, the citizens of Prince Rupert in massed meeting assembled, records their inflexible determination to continue to a victorious end the struggle in maintenance of those ideals of

liberty and justice, which are the common cause of the Allies.

"God Save the King," followed by three cheers for His Majesty, brought a historic meeting to a close.
