DROP IN GERMAN EXPORTS TO AMERICA

The effect of the war on the trade of this country with Germany is shown in a statement of the declared value of exports to the United States through the ports of Hamburg, Kiel and Luebeck during the first six months of this year, made public by the Department of Commerce. During the first six months of 1914, these ports sent to the United States goods valued at \$14,994,585. This year in the same period, the shipments amounted to \$1,153,257. Hamburg, which handled the bulk of the trade, fell off from more than \$13,000,000 in American exports to a little more than \$1,000,000.—Dun's Review.
